


Project Title: Kinnerton Confectionery Factory Building
Description: Construction of a new confectionery production facility
Client: Kinnerton Confectionery
Value: £3.75M
Duration: 11Months



The project consisted of a 27,000ft² steel framed, fully clad food production building, incorporating production areas, laboratory, offices and welfare facilities. Construction methods included CFA piled foundations, raised ground floor with undercroft, PCC first floor, PCC fire wall, composite roofing (incorporating a single ply membrane), 2,500m² of concrete and associated works.

Key to the successful completion of this project was the careful planning and co-ordination between our construction team and the client's project team. The building was constructed independently of the adjacent facility and then linked during the final phase of work.
